Questions on the Bishop's Pastoral Letter: Section 1: A Call to Move from Maintenance to Mission.



"As a diocese, and in deed as a Church around the world, we are at a turning point. We live in such a time that God in His Providence seems to have offered us a chance: we can either continue to watch the decline of the Church or we can take up our mission anew with faith, courage and passion. For me, the choice is clear. We must rouse ourselves out of complacency. We must courageously move past simply maintaining our programs and structures and allow the Lord to lead us into deep renewal of our identity and purpose."

1. How would you describe your parish? Is it vibrant and growing, simply maintaining, or declining in active members? How motivated is your parish to draw new people in?
2. How in your life have you experienced the painful reality of friends and family leaving the Church?
3. What are your perceptions of the word 'evangelization'? Have you ever heard this word used in relation to the mission of the Catholic Church?

Please take time to pray and answer these questions. Then share them with your friends. If you would like to share them with me, just call the Office and I will schedule a time to meet with you and your friends.
