A New Roof for Ss. Peter & Paul: This weekend we officially begin our Campaign to "RAISE THE ROOF!" We didn't want to start this campaign until our festival was over and before the CSA begins for the new year. The total cost of the project is \$256,000. The other parishes in the

cluster will pay their portion for the rectory and the parish office. Ss. Peter & Paul parishioners will be responsible for our portion of the rectory, the parish office plus the church and the hall. The Ss. Peter & Paul Building Maintenance fund will add \$106,000. The chart above gives a breakdown of how much we need to raise. I know \$129,500 sounds like a lot of money but I know that we can do it. Just think of your ancestors when they looked at the cost of building the first church, or the current church. They too thought how could we do this but here we are celebrating Mass and enjoying the fruits of their labors. We can do this with the help of almighty God. We all need to take time to pray asking God *what can I pledge that will help this campaign meet its goal?* We need the pledge to become a reality so that the roof can be replaced and the legacy that your ancestors began so long ago can remain a testament of the Catholic Faith in western Taylor County.
