ORDINARY TIME & the LITURGICAL YEAR

Did You Know!

During the **liturgical year**, the bishop or priest wears vestments of different liturgical colors at Mass. The colors relate to the particular season or feast being celebrated. **Green** which symbolizes life and hope is used during **Ordinary Time**. **Purple** symbolizes penance and is use during **Advent and Lent**. It may also be used on All Souls' Day and Masses for the Dead. **White** symbolizes purity and triumph. It is used during the Christmas and Easter season, feasts of Jesus and Mary, Holy Thursday, feast of angels and non-martyred saints, at weddings and also at funerals. **Red** stands for blood and fire. It is used on Pentecost, Palm Sunday, Good Friday, feast of the Holy Cross and the martyrs, and Masses in honor of the Holy Spirit.

Since we are beginning **Ordinary Time**, the priest wears green and we will celebrate everything about Jesus! We hear about his teaching, his love and his forgiveness. We also learn to be his followers and increase our faith. We learn of our new life and hope in Jesus. We follow Jesus' example by praying, loving others and working for justice and peace. Ordinary Time is the longest season of the Church year. It lasts about thirty-three or thirty-four weeks. It is called Ordinary Time because the weeks are ordered, or named in number order. **Ordinary Time begins after the Christmas season on the Monday after the Baptism of our Lord** and continues until Ash Wednesday. We then have the Lenten and Easter seasons until **Ordinary Time resumes on the Monday after Pentecost**. Ordinary Time continues until the end of the Church year when Advent begins.
