ONE MINUTE MEDITATIONS

God never stops loving us. God’s love is like sunlight – nothing can stop it from shining. But you can shut your eyes or pull the shades down to lessen the light. When we sin, we stop God’s love from entering into us. Avoiding sin is like stepping out of the shadows back into the sun.

The risk of faith- John 6:60-69. Faith means taking a risk. It means believing and trusting without understanding. That’s not to say that faith ensures we won’t ever have doubts – even our greatest saints suffered from the “night of the soul.” Yet it is not God who causes doubts and uncertainty, but our own human weaknesses. Faith is also a test. Jesus said that he is the very life of God come down from Heaven and no can live without Him. He is the very bread of our lives. If we believe in Him, we pass the test of faith. Many of the disciples did not. Perhaps you have been disappointed by a friend or loved one, or you felt alone and unwanted. It may help to remember Peter’s response to Jesus, “Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life.” Jesus is the loved one who never disappoints and who will always be with you. There’s no risk in believing in Him.

Angels in all of us. While we may imagine angels to be heavenly creatures with wings, some angels are rooted on Earth. When we bring God’s message of love to others through caring and supportive friendship, we are acting in an angelic way.

Look for laughs. There’s an old saying, “Your day goes the same way as the corners of your mouth.” Spend some time each day looking for opportunities to smile. If you don’t see any, make them happen.
