Born in Capistrano, Italy, John studied law and was appointed governor of Perugia. During war with a neighboring town, he was imprisoned which caused him to change his life. St. Francis of Assisi appeared to him in a dream and told him to become a Franciscan. When he was released, he became a Franciscan monk. He followed the example of St. Francis and became a great preacher, speaking to thousands of people.
