#### PRAYER, FASTING & ALMSGIVING

Heavenly Father, as I enter another week of my Lenten Journey, guide me to the path that leads to you. Fill my heart with gratitude, patience and peace as I strive to become the best-version-of-myself, honestly admitting my shortcomings and sins.

#### St. POLYCARP, Bishop & Martyr (70 - 155)

St. Polycarp was one of the most revered of the Apostolic fathers - **the generation of bishops who received their faith from the original Apostles.** Born only 69 years after Jesus, he was a disciple of St. John the Evangelist. St. John passed down to St. Polycarp the events of Jesus' life and the truths of the faith.

Polycarp became the bishop of Smyrna (Turkey) and taught to faithful Christians all that he learned from St. John. When he was an old man, the emperor was persecuting Christians because they did not believe the emperor was God. St. Polycarp had a vision that predicted his martyrdom and his role as a witness to Christ. Polycarp was arrested and officials could not convince him to worship the emperor. He heard a voice from heaven say, "Be strong, O Polycarp!" Other people heard the voice too. A fire was lit, but the flames fanned into an arc, forming a flaming wall that surrounded Polycarp, but did not hurt him. This miracle gave courage to the Christians watching, and they wrote down all that was seen, so future Christians would have courage. The executioner ordered that Polycarp be killed by the sword, and he died as a witness of his love for Jesus.
