Biblical Origins of the Mass

The Mass you attend today may not look and sound like a Mass that was celebrated 100 years ago. Changes have been made through the centuries, but the Mass itself has been around since the beginning of the Christian Church. The Mass has its beginnings at the Last Supper. These accounts are found in the Gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke. To this day, the priest echoes the words of Jesus at every Mass. In Acts 2:42, the first Christians “devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles, and to the communal life, to the breaking of the bread and to the prayers.” St. Paul refers to the Mass in 1 Corinthians 11, “For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes.”
