## TEACH US TO PRAY

Jesus teaches his disciples a version of the most famous Christian prayer, the Lord's Prayer. Luke's version is simple and direct. We pray that God's name will be recognized as holy and that his rule over all will be established. This is followed by petitions for our need for bread, for forgiveness and for deliverance. The parable and concluding teaching should not lead us to think of prayer as a series of requests presented to God. Instead, prayer consists in recognizing God's holiness and his rule over all things.
