December 27th, we celebrate **St. John the Evangelist.** John was the beloved disciple, the youngest of the Twelve. Jesus always called John to accompany Him in special moments: he was at Jesus' Transfiguration and with Jesus in the Garden of Gethsemane. During the Last Supper, John rested his head against Jesus and heard Jesus' heart beating with love for the whole world. John never abandoned Jesus when He was in trouble. John followed Jesus when He was arrested in the Garden of Gethsemane. He was at Jesus' feet at the Crucifixion and comforted Jesus' Mother and later cared for Mary as would a son. John believed Mary Magdalene that Jesus was Risen and that she saw Him. John saw the empty tomb and burial cloths. Later, John, Peter and other disciples went fishing but could not catch anything on the sea. A stranger on shore instructed them to cast their nets once again in to the deep. This time fish rushed into their nets almost breaking the nets with their weight. John saw that the stranger was Jesus! John lived to an old age. He wrote the Fourth Gospel, which describes Jesus as the Son of God and flies to such heights of wisdom that John is symbolized with the eagle. He also wrote three letters and the final book of the Bible, Revelation. You can read all that John the beloved disciple wrote in the Bible.
