EASTER

Easter is the name given to the Feast of the Resurrection of Our Lord. It is the greatest feast of the church. It celebrates Our Lord rising from the dead on the third day after His burial. His glorious triumph over death is the strongest proof of His divinity. Easter Sunday is the first Sunday after the first full moon which occurs on or after March 21. Easter may occur as early as March 22 and as late as April 25. Catholics have an obligation or duty to receive Holy Communion during the Easter time. This is one of the six laws of the Church and must be obeyed by all Catholics who have reached the age of seven or have received First Holy Communion. In the United States, our Easter season is the fifty day period in the Church year when we celebrate Christ's resurrection. The Easter season begins with Easter Sunday and ends with the feast of Pentecost.

On Easter Sunday, on the altar, we see the new paschal candle lighted (first lit on Saturday at the Easter Vigil). We see all the Easter flowers and Easter lilies and decorations from the night before. The early blooming Bermuda lily, with its striking white, trumpet-shaped blossom, is imported and is now widely accepted in the United States as the Easter lily. In decorating, white is the principal color used. And again, the choir and the people will sing Alleluia, which means "Praise the Lord".

Every Sunday is like a little Easter. Jesus Christ is risen today, our triumphant holy day! Through his victorious resurrection the gates of heaven are eternally opened to all those who follow him faithfully. Share the joyous Easter news...

Christ the Lord is risen for you !
