From the Pastor's Desk:

Thank you for welcoming me into the "Five Saints Cluster." Everyone has been so kind and friendly. To the people of St. Stanislaus in Lublin and St. John in Sheldon, thank you for going the extra mile and serving my favorite goodies. I look forward to meeting all of you and working with you to learn more about Jesus Christ, the saints, and your faith story as you will continue to learn about mine. Thanks again!

The Sacraments are an outward sign instituted by God to give grace. The outward signs point to what's happening inside our bodies. How God's grace marks our soul for Him, cleanses, feeds, and purifies our soul so God can dwell there. "The Holy Spirit prepares the faithful for the sacraments by the Word of God and the faith which welcomes that word in well-disposed hearts. Thus, the sacraments strengthen faith and express it." (CCC. 1133) There are seven sacraments. The Initiation Sacraments are Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation. The Healing Sacraments are the Anointing of the Sick and Reconciliation. The Sacrament of Service are Marriage and Holy Orders. The sacraments use common/ordinary things as outward signs; e.g., water, olive oil, a candle. It is very important for all of us to remember that the sacraments are for the living.

The Sacrament of Baptism is the first sacrament received by anyone who enters the Catholic faith. You can receive this sacrament if you were never baptized, or you belong to a Christian church where they do not baptize in water and the Spirit. There is no age limit, which means you are eligible to receive the gift of baptism from the moment you are born till the moment before you die. The outward sign is the pouring of water or being immersed in the water and the words are "(the person's name), I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen." This is the greatest gift our children can receive from their parents that is becoming one of God's children through the spirit of adoption.

The celebration of the sacrament of Baptism. The Church's preferred way to celebrate the sacrament of baptism (that is of any age) is during the Mass. The sacrament of baptism is to be celebrated in the presence of the community. With that said, the Church prefers the sacrament to be celebrated during the Mass; so that the community gets to experience another child or adult joining in the family of God. There are also special graces given to those who witness this beautiful sacrament. The other option is to celebrate outside the Mass with your closest family and friends. I will share the benefits of celebrating both ways and will allow the parents to make their choice of which way we will be celebrating their child's baptism.
