Dear Friends:

Those who do not believe in God and in a God who cares for us are liable to be bogged down with worries more than others. We Christians who worship God as our Father should not needlessly worry. God is like a mother to us. "Does a woman forget her baby? Yet, even if these forget, I will never forget you" was God's own assurance. The basic cause of most of our worries is a failure to live our life on a day to day basis. The crosses we make for ourselves by a restless anxiety as to the future are not crosses from God. Of course, it is wise to be prudent and wise to plan for the future and take responsible actions to solve our problems. Providence of God does not assist the idle. But Jesus taught us that we should not be too anxious about the future because we have a heavenly Father who knows what we need and will provide; "I am telling you not to worry about your life and what you are to eat nor about your body and what you are to wear. Your heavenly Father knows you need them all". A person who believes what Jesus has said will agree with the hymn writer who wrote; "I know not what the future holds, but know who holds the future." In any case, it does not make sense to worry about the future, because why open an umbrella before it starts to rain?

Therefore, instead of getting worried about our material needs, Jesus asks us to seek God's kingdom first. "Set your hearts on God's kingdom first and God's saving justice and all these other things will be given you as well" (Mt 6:33). Everyone wants the kingdom of God but few want it first. But the divine promise is that if we give God our first priority in our lives, we can rest assured that our needs will be supplied and there will be no need to worry.
