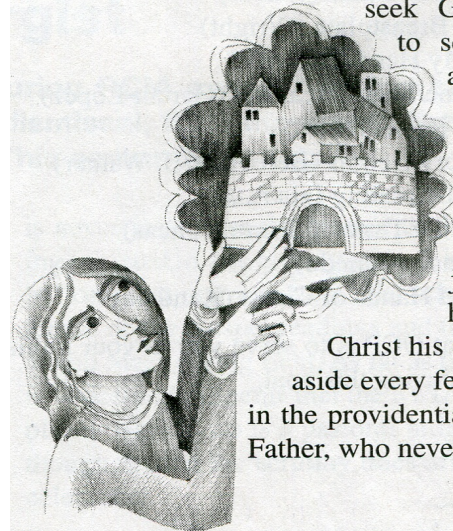

### SEEK GOD FIRST
