**YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH**

Pope Francis released an Apostolic Letter on December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020 about St. Joseph and declared a "Year of St. Joseph" to be observed until December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

Pope Francis noted that this year marks the 150th anniversary of the saint's proclamation as patron of the Universal Church by Pope Pius IX on Dec. 8, 1870. Pope Francis wrote, "Each of us can discover in Joseph -- the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence -- an intercessor, a support and a guide in times of trouble". He also said he wanted to highlight St. Joseph's role as a father who served his family with charity and humility, adding, "Our world today needs fathers."
