**On January 23<sup>rd</sup>, we celebrate the feast day of St. Marianne Cope(1838-1918).** Born in Germany, here parents immigrated to the United States in 1840. Ever since she was young, she believed God had called her to be a nun. Marianne Cope joined the Franciscan sisters, eventually elected Mother Superior and ran a local hospital. In 1883, the Hawaiian government asked Sr. Marianne to come to Hawaii to take care of the lepers. At that time there was no cure for leprosy, but Sr. Marianne’s heart leapt at the opportunity to serve the lepers in Hawaii. She and six nuns served the patients with tenderness and love and she opened a home for the young girls whose parents had leprosy. Sr. Marianne eventually moved to the island of Molokai where the most hopeless cases of leprosy were sent. She took care of the lepers and Fr. Damien, who would later become a saint. She comforted the dying priest and promised that she would care for his beloved lepers. For the rest of her life, she took care of the lepers until her death at age 80.
