**REGARDING CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS**: here's how the CARES Act changed charitable contributions made in 2020:

Previously, charitable contributions could only be deducted if taxpayers itemized their deductions. Under this new change, taxpayers who don't itemize deductions, can claim an "above-the-line" deduction of up to \$300 for cash donations made to charity during 2020. This means the deduction lowers both adjusted gross income and taxable income – translating into tax savings for those making donations to qualifying tax-exempt organizations. Qualifying organizations are those that are religious, charitable, educational, scientific or literary in purpose. The law changed in this area due to the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act. More information about these changes is available on IRS.gov
