On February 3rd, we celebrate the feast day of St. Blaise. Not much is known about St. Blaise except that he was a doctor, a bishop and a martyr. As a doctor he healed the sick, but he wanted to heal people's souls, so he became a bishop so he could minister the sacraments and forgive people's sins. Christians were persecuted at this time and Blaise was arrested because he wouldn't renounce his Christian faith. A woman brought her son to him because he had a fish bone caught in his throat. Blaise prayed to God for a cure, and the boy was healed. Despite this miracle, the governor still ordered Blaise to be tortured and put to death. On February 3rd, a priest may give the 'blessing of the throats' after Mass by holding two crossed candles to your throat while saying these words, "Through the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness: in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit."

St. Blaise, protect me from all sickness, especially sickness of the throat!
