GIFTS AND FRUITS

Lent is a great time to help others and use your gifts of the Holy Spirit and your talents. We received them for a reason. These seven permanent gifts were given to us by the Holy Spirit to make it easier to respond to God's call to holiness and receive grace. These gifts are given at Baptism and are strengthened in Confirmation.

The first gift is **Wisdom** which is the ability to put God first, to love the things of God, and to see things from God's point of view and therefore to make good judgements. **Understanding** is our second gift that gives insight into the truths of the faith. It enables a person to know the meaning and consequences of what God has revealed. **Counsel**, the third gift, leads one to seek and be open to good advice when making decisions, as well as being able to give good advice. Counsel is also called right judgement. **Fortitude**, gift number four, is the strength and courage to do what is right even when it is difficult. The fifth gift, **Knowledge**, helps us to know God and know what he expects of us. Knowledge helps us find the correct path to heaven. Gift number six, **Piety**, helps us love and worship God. It leads to prayer and to a deep respect for God and all God's creation, including other people. Our last gift is **Fear of the Lord**, means reverence, wonder and awe in response to God's complete holiness. God knows all, can do all, and is perfect in every way. These gifts can be used again and again. They never run out and they work best when you use them for others needs.

The Fruits of the Holy Spirit have characteristics and qualities for those who allow themselves to be guided by the Holy Spirit.

There are twelve fruits of the Holy Spirit. They are: **charity, joy, peace, patience, goodness, kindness, generosity, humility, faithfulness, modesty, self-control and chastity.** The gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit help us become One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolate as stated in the Four Marks of the Church.
