I found this definition while looking at some Lent information. Lent is the time when we repent. "Repent" does not mean "to turn one's life around": that is conversion. **Repent in Latin means "to rethink"**. To see the world and our lives as Jesus does: that is the beginning of repentance. Yes, Lent is a time of change. Sort of like Spring cleaning for our soul!

Pretzels originated as little rewards made by the monks and given to children as they learned their prayers. The form of the pretzel represents two arms folded in prayer, as a reminder of the importance of prayer. The three openings in the pretzel remind us of the Holy Trinity - Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Saint Patrick used this same idea with a shamrock. The three parts of the shamrock were his representation of the Holy Trinity. His feast day is March 17 and he converted many people to Christianity in Ireland. Consider wearing green for Patrick and for Spring!

March 19th is the Solemnity of St. Joseph, husband of Mary and foster father of Jesus on Earth. He is the head of the Holy Family: poor in worldly terms of possessions but rich in grace and virtue. He is the "breadwinner" of the Holy Family through his work as a carpenter. Celebrate this day with some special bread and a prayer to St. Joseph!
