St. John Paul II (Feast Day - October 22nd). Karol Wojtyla was a young man when the Nazis took over his home country of Poland during World War II. The Nazis wanted to destroy Polish identity so they closed universities and seminaries. Karol helped start a secret theater company which put on plays to inspire, give hope and remind the Polish people who they were. More importantly, he entered the seminary in secret to study for the priesthood. At the end of World War II, now a priest, Karol served as chaplain for Krakow University. He later became a professor, an archbishop and a cardinal. In 1978, after the death of John Paul I, he was elected pope taking the name John Paul II in honor of the pope who had just passed away. Pope John Paul II traveled more than any other pope in history. He drew large crowds and told the people "Be not afraid!" and invited them to welcome Jesus into their hearts. He started World Youth Day, which is a gathering of young people from all over the world to celebrate Jesus together. He wrote many important works, especially on the importance of love and marriage. St. John Paul II, help me not to be afraid to welcome Jesus into my heart!
