**Ss. Peter & Paul Religious Education Registration** will be held on Sunday, September 20<sup>th</sup> after Mass at 9:30 a.m. AND on Thursday, September 24<sup>th</sup> from 5:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.

**St. John Religious Education Registration** will be held on Wednesday, September 30<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.

**ALL students must be registered by October 2<sup>nd</sup>** as materials will be ordered on October 5<sup>th</sup>. We are still working through the necessary requirements by the Diocese, so the start dates and times of all classes will not be confirmed until we meet with you at Registration. We are not mailing the registration packets to families, so you must plan to attend a registration meeting. An informational letter will be sent with the registration dates and times that I have listed above.

**Classes will be held once a month for Grades K-1 and for Grades 3-10.** The Sacramental classes for **Grade 2 and for Grade 11 will meet twice a month.** Parents will instruct their children the other weeks of the month.
