REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

Ss. Peter & Paul Religious Education Registration will be held on Sunday, September 20th after Mass at 9:30 a.m. AND on Thursday, September 24th from 5:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.

St. John Religious Education Registration will be held on Wednesday, September 30th from 6:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m.

ALL students must be registered by October 2nd as materials will be ordered on October 5th. We are not mailing the registration packets to families, so you must plan to attend a registration meeting.

Classes will be held once a month for Grades K-1 and for Grades 3-10. The Sacramental classes for **Grade 2 and for Grade 11 will meet twice a month.** Children are expected to attend Mass with their parents or family members every week.

September 1st marks the five-year anniversary of the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation in the Catholic Church. On this day last year, Pope Francis encouraged the faithful to observe the **Season of Creation** – an ecumenical initiative that begins September 1 and ends on October 4, the Feast of St. Francis of Assisi – through increased prayer and a simpler lifestyle.

"We invite every Catholic and all people of good will who care for our common home in the United States to increase efforts towards ecological conversion during this **Season of Creation**. May our prayers and our witness reflect the words and deeds of Jesus, who 'went about doing good and healing' (Acts 10:38)."
