## LENTEN PLEDGE

Making a pledge at the beginning of Lent each year is a long-standing tradition. A lenten pledge is a promise that is kept during the period of Lent. It is meant to bring us closer to God and to help us do his will in our lives. In order to follow Jesus, we must follow his example. **What are things we can do in our lives to act as Jesus wants?** Some possible suggestions are: learn a new prayer, help someone with chores, smile at someone everyday, invite a lonely person or a shut-in to dinner or an activity, say grace before meals, or pray for those who are ill. It helps to write out your pledge. Encourage younger children to trace their foot or shoe on a sheet of paper and write their Lenten promise on the shape to show how they will **follow in Jesus' footsteps during Lent.** All of us need to write out our pledge to make it 'real'. Consider writing a Lent letter to God and share how the spirit of the season can be carried out in your life. Whatever you promise in Lent, make it meaningful for you!
