ST. JAMES, Apostle - JULY 25

James (brother of John the Apostle) is one of the first disciples to join Jesus. As member of the inner circle, James witnessed the raising of Jairus's daughter from the dead (Mark 5:37 and Luke 8:51), the Transfiguration (Mark 9:2), and Jesus' agony in the Garden of Gethsemane (Mark 14:33 and Matthew 26:37). James and John asked Jesus to let them sit, one at his right and one at his left, in his future glory (Mark 10:35-40), a favor that Jesus said was not his to grant. James was beheaded by order of King Herod; the only apostle whose martyrdom is recorded in the New Testament (Acts 12:2). His body was taken to Santiago de Compostela, Spain, where his shrine attracts Christian pilgrims from all over the world.
