Synod of the World's Bishops (October 2023)

Pope Francis has called this Synod to discuss the very notion of Synodality, with the three main themes being Communion, Participation and Mission. Pope Francis has said on numerous occasions that he sees this synod in many ways as a fulfillment of the Second Vatican Council, the central teaching of which was the Universal Call to Holiness. By virtue of our baptism, we are all called to the Church's mission of evangelization. The Holy Father is asking us to grow in true communion with the Lord and with each other, to grow in relationship with each other that we might be able to bring out all the faithful's gifts and charisms.

In preparation for the Synod taking place in Rome in 2023, there will be two prior phases of the Synod. The first phase will happen at our local, Diocesan level from this October until April of 2022. During this time, we are being asked to pray and reflect with the entire People of God on the mission of the Church and how the Holy Spirit is moving to lead us - all of us - into a deeper sense of and commitment to Communion, Participation and Mission.

We stand before You, Holy Spirit,
