### The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed All Souls' Day -November 2

We pray in a special way for those who have died. The souls of the faithful departed have special need of prayers to help them get to heaven. We can ask God to be merciful on the departed souls and give them the life of His grace.

On this day, say a special prayer for someone who passed away this year. Pray for those in your family who have died. Also, pray for those who have no one else to pray for them and are forgotten by those on earth. In purgatory, souls from every time and place are being purified so they can be holy enough to enter heaven. These souls will especially be thankful for your prayers.

A special blessing is given to departed souls in purgatory if you visit a Catholic cemetery on November 2<sup>nd</sup> or during the rest of the week and pray for them. You can earn for these souls an indulgence. Which means that they will spend less time suffering in purgatory!

You can pray this prayer for the dead:

**Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord,**

**And let perpetual light shine upon them.**

**May they rest in peace.**

**Amen.**

Remember, if you pray for the souls in purgatory then they will pray for you too!

### St. Charles Borromeo - November 4<sup>th</sup> (Italy 1538 - 1584)

Charles Borromeo knew God was calling him to serve the Church when he was twelve and entered the monastery. At twenty-two, he went to Rome to serve his uncle, Pope Pius IV as a Church official.

The Church was facing many struggles, including the Protestant Reformation which swayed people against the Catholic Church. At twenty-six years old, Charles became archbishop of Milan, the largest diocese in the Catholic Church at the time and a city where corruption was rampant. His mission was to root out ignorance and his strategy was to provide education to the clergy by establishing schools, seminaries and colleges. Charles worked hard to keep people true to the Catholic faith and encouraged everyone to live the way Jesus did - in service, love and poverty.
