St. Vincent de Paul (September 27th)

As a young priest, Vincent de Paul was sailing on a ship and was captured by pirates who sold him into slavery in North Africa. He served three masters and the third was a Catholic who had left the faith. The master's wife heard Vincent de Paul singing "Hail Holy Queen", a beautiful hymn in honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The wife was enchanted, returned to her husband and asked how he could have given up a faith so beautiful. Vincent de Paul brought his master back to the Catholic faith and the all escaped back to France.

Now Vincent de Paul could return to serving the people of France as a priest. He founded a congregation of priests and helped found an order of nuns, the Daughters of Charity, who looked after the poor and the sick. One snowy night, he found an abandoned child in the streets. Sadly, this practice was common for poor, unwanted babies. He brought the child to a home to look after him. Soon he and a group of kind ladies started a home for abandoned children in Paris.

St. Vincent de Paul did many good works, caring for the poor, the sick and the abandoned. He served God and others with love until he died a holy death in old age.
